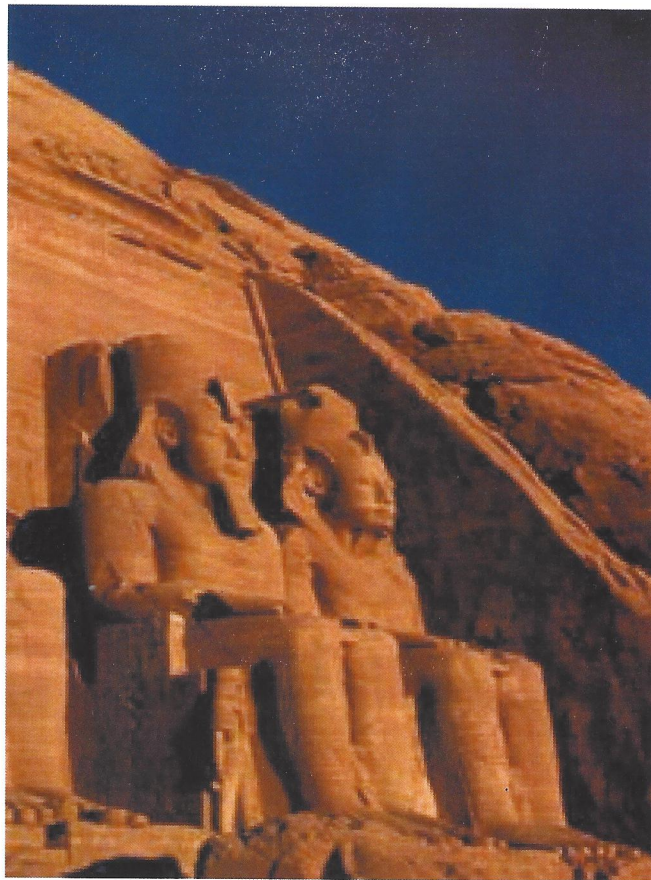

EGYPT (KMT) July 27 – August 7, 2019

DAY 01: Depart from New York JFK Airport via Egypt Air in the late afternoon for your flight to Cairo with meals served on board the flight.

DAY 02: THE LAND OF THE ANCIENTS: Arrive into Cairo and clear customs with transfer to your hotel. Get some rest and then attend a Welcome Dinner in the evening followed by the opening session of the 50th Anniversary Conference. Stay overnight in Cairo (D)

DAY 03: MEMPHIS/ SAKKARA/ GIZA: Following breakfast tour the ancient capital of Memphis and the ancient necropolis of Sakkara. Visit Giza with the Pyramids of Kufu, Karfre, and Menkara, the Solar Boat and the Hor-em-Aket (The Sphinx). You will have time for some local shopping between stops. Conference session lecture in the evening following dinner. Stay overnight in Cairo (B/D)

DAY 04: CAIRO: Following breakfast, you will take a city tour of Cairo visiting the Egyptian Museum, Old Cairo, the Citadel and be able to test your bargaining skills. Return to your hotel. Conference session in the evening following dinner. Stay overnight in Cairo. (B/D)

DAY 05: CAIRO/ABU SIMBEL/ASWAN: Hotel check out following breakfast with airport transfers for your flight to Abu Simbel to visit the great monument temples of Ramesses II marking the hallmark of the Nubian Campaign. Both temples are UNESCO World Heritage Monuments and will be spectacles to behold! Visit the shops and haggle with the vendors before taking your return flight back to Aswan. Check into your hotel and take the remainder of the day for your personal exploration and relaxation. (B/D)

DAY 06: ASWAN: Following breakfast have a half day of conference sessions. In the evening visit a Nubian village and the Nubian Museum for a guided tour and time permitting visit the markets in Aswan. Stay overnight in Aswan, (B/C/D)

DAY 07: ASWAN: Following breakfast, check out of your hotel and embark on your Deluxe Nile Cruise in time for lunch. After lunch visit the High Dam and the Temple of Auset on the Island of Philae. Take a felucca sail boat ride on the Nile and then return to your ship for High Tea in the afternoon. Take some rest and then have a Welcome Cocktail by the Captain followed by dinner. In the evening enjoy a cultural Nubian Show. Stay overnight on board in Aswan. (B/L/D)

DAY 08: KOM OMBO/ EDFU/ ESNA: Following breakfast you will sail from Aswan to Kom Ombo where you will visit the healing temple that is shared by two ancient gods, Sobek and Haeroris. Return to your ship and take lunch as you sail to Edfu. Following lunch you will visit the Temple dedicated to Horus at Edfu. Return to your ship and sail to Esna. Have afternoon tea and later dinner onboard followed by a Galabeya Party. Stay overnight in Esna. (B/L/D)

DAY 09: WASET: Take your early breakfast after an early morning sail to Luxor. Following breakfast you will visit the Valley of the Kings and Queens and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at El-Deir El-Bahari and the Colossi of Memnon. Return to your ship for lunch and then visit the East Bank of the Nile to see both Ipet Isut and the Southern Ipet Temples. Take afternoon tea. Dinner will be served followed by music and dancing in the evening. Overnight in Luxor. (B/L/D)

DAY 10: WASET: Disembark from your cruise ship where you will depart for the Asa Restoration Project Site for a special ceremony celebrating the 50th Anniversary of the African Historical Society Association with special libations and honoring the memory of Baba Asa Hillard. Return to your hotel for some rest and maybe later some shopping time. In the evening attend a lecture by Prof. Anthony "Tony" Browder. Stay overnight in Luxor. (B/D)

DAY 11: WASET/CAIRO: Transfer to the airport for a return flight back to Cairo after breakfast. Transfer to your hotel for a Farewell Dinner and the Closing Conference Session. Stay overnight in Cairo (B/D)

DAY 12: NEW YORK: Early morning check out of your hotel with transfers to the airport. Go through custom formalities and board your return flight home with meals served onboard. You will arrive at JFK Airport in time to make transfers for your connecting flights home and the end of a memorable and historical 50th Anniversary Celebration. **BON VOYAGE!**

TRAVEL CONDITIONS

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Economy jet IATA carriers and based on a minimum of 15 persons traveling on the same itinerary departing from New York/JFK Airport. Airfares are not guaranteed until ticketed and are subject to change. Newton-Thoth, Inc./ Sebayit Tours is not responsible for any deviations, stopovers or price changes issued by the airlines.

BAGGAGE: Limited to two normal size suitcases with no more than 50 pounds each and one carry-on bag in addition to purses, briefcases, or computers.

MEALS: Meals are served on board the international flights. A daily meal plan is specified in the full itinerary. Beverages are at the expense of each passenger. The meal plan legend is: B = Breakfast; L = Lunch; D = Dinner.

OCCUPANCY: All price quotes are per person and based on double occupancy. A limited number of single rooms are available for an additional fee of \$600.00. Single supplemental fees must be paid prior to the departure date and are subject to a first come basis.

CHANGES: Name changes are allowed. There is a \$50.00 net service fee for any and every change involving names, departure cities, and/ or for any changes made within 45 days of departure.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Tour participants may cancel space without penalty up to 75 days prior to departure. A cancellation fee of \$200.00 per person will be assessed for reservations canceled between 74-60 days prior to departure. A \$300.00 cancellation fee will be assessed for reservations canceled between 59 – 45 days prior to departure. A fee of \$500.00 will be assessed for cancellations made between 44 – 30 days prior to departure. Cancellations made from 29 - 15 days prior to departure will be assessed \$750.00. Cancellations made 14 days or less from the departure date and “no-shows”, receive no refunds. **There is no refund in the event of interruption or cancellations made by guests after the start of the tour. We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation insurance.** We can provide you with high quality trip cancellation and trip interruption insurance including medical coverage and a “Free to Go” Plan in the event of any terrorist incidents. BOOKING & PAYMENT: Tour participants are required to make a deposit of \$500.00 in order to secure passage on the tour. All payments must be made in full at least sixty days prior to the departure date of the tour. IMPORTANT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

This conference tour package is a set itinerary. Any deviations or changes made by individuals must be done in advance and will be at an additional cost to the participant.

Conference registration for the 50th Anniversary must be made directly with the African Heritage Society Association and not through the offices of Newton-Thoth, Inc./Sebayit Tours

Visas into Egypt can be secured upon at the airport in Cairo upon arrival with cash of \$25.00 U.S. Visa fees are not a part of the total cost of the tour package. Visa fees are subject to change.

Your airline ticket allows for two checked bags. Any extra bags or overweight bags will incur an additional expense that is set by the airlines and not a part of this tour package.

Children under the age of 18 years must travel with an adult over 21 years of age. Minor children not traveling with a biological parent must have a special authorization form from the biological parent in order to travel on this tour. This form will be supplied by our office. Failure to have this notarized form submitted at least sixty days prior to departure will delay or inhibit travel for the minor.

Children under 12 years of age are generally charged 75% of the adult airfare by the airlines. Please check with our office to ensure that this rule still applies. Children under the age of 12 years staying in the room with an adult are generally not charged hotel fees. However, this varies with each hotel and please check with us at the time you make your deposit payment for details and updates.

It is advisable, if you are using a credit cards during your trip, that you consider using only MasterCard and Visa as American Express is not accepted at all stores when shopping. Cash still remains king and you can get Egyptian pounds at ATM machines. Please call your credit card company prior to your trip departure date and notify them that you will be out of the country. Failure to do this may put a block on your credit card by your bank.

Don't forget to stop all newspaper and mail delivery while you are out of the country unless you have someone at home or have designated someone to pick it up daily for you. No need to notify potential criminals of your absence.

Do not pack medications or your passport in checked bags. Put these items in your carry- on bags in case your luggage is delayed in arriving.

Make copies of your passport and place one copy in each of your checked bags as well as one copy in your hand luggage. This is in addition to the original document that will be in your hand bag. In addition, leave a copy at home in case for some reason you lose your passport and need to replace it.

Buy your film and camera supplies at home and take them with you as these items are very expensive outside of the USA.

Get an international calling plan for your cell phone for testing and calling. Roaming charges overseas are very expensive. You can get a daily plan with most phone companies or a monthly plan as well.
