The HR Committee met on October 5, 2020. The Agenda for the regularly scheduled meeting was to review and approve actions related to the 2020 Performance Evaluation for the Executive Director.

The Committee also voted to conduct a comparability study examining salary and benefits for positions comparable to ASALH's human resources staff. Such a study has not been conducted in recent years and it is important that ASALH remains competitive in this area. Loss of comparability has an impact on an organization's total workforce and makes personnel recruitment challenging across the board. Our initial review suggests that this study can be completed for about \$1,000 and can be funded within ASALH's existing budget.
