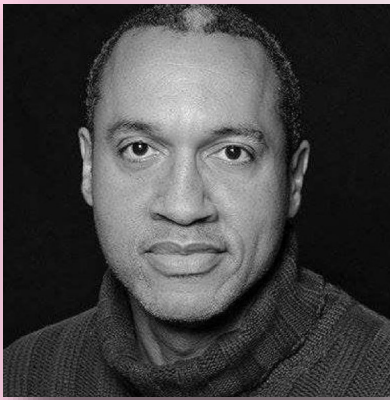

"Research on The Legacy of Slavery in Maryland"

Archivist/Historian/Writer/Actor/Filmmaker Chris Haley, who currently serves as Director of the Study of the Legacy of Slavery at the Maryland State Archives will share an overview of slavery's impact on Maryland's Black (and White) citizens as discovered through the program he has supervised for over 10 years. This virtual presentation will include images of runaway ads, domestic traffic notices, laws, and other documents which reveal the surprisingly complex, brutal and diverse nature of the 'peculiar institution' in Maryland.

Mr. Haley is the Director of Research for the Study of the Legacy of Slavery in Maryland at the Maryland State Archives, Director of the Utopia Film Festival in Prince George's County, and current Annapolis Film Festival Advisory Board Member. Additionally, he has served on the following boards: Kunta Kinte-Alex Haley Foundation, Historic London Town Foundation, Jake Savage Foundation, and the Annapolis Arts Alliance Foundation. His script for the 2004 *The RECONCILIATION WALK for SLAVERY and PENITENCE* held in Annapolis on September 29 helped garner the Maryland Tourism Council Global Marketing Award for the Kunta Kinte-Alex Haley Foundation.
