DID YOU KNOW?

The author of the book *Hidden Figures*, Margot Lee Shetterfly, reached out to the Hampton Roads Branch of ASALH to help her find grant funds to conduct the research to write the book entitled *Hidden Figures* that ultimately led to the movie. Ms. Shetterly notes the following statement in her book: "My deepest gratitude to Audrey Williams, President of the Hampton Roads Chapter of the Association for the Study of African American Life and History (ASALH) which served as sponsor for the seed stage of the Human Computer Project," which became the book/film *Hidden Figures*.

DID YOU KNOW?

Ancestor Dr. Harriett Jenkins, one of ASALH's Centennial Ray of Light Honorees, was the Assistant Administrator of NASA who first recruited African American astronauts to the NASA. Charlie Bolden who was one of Dr. Jenkin's first recruits, was honored as an ASALH Centennial Ray of Light while serving as the first African American Administrator of NASA. Later, we discovered that Dr. Jenkins was a friend and colleague of the women sited in the book *Hidden Figures*; Dr. Jenkins was a mathematician and graduate of Fisk University.

DID YOU KNOW?

In 2005, the Maryland State Department of Education purchased 24 institutional memberships for all of its public school jurisdictions. What are the names of the brothers who founded the Washington-based Afro-American Bicentennial Corporation (ABC) that in 1976 was responsible for gaining Landmark status for the Carter. G. Woodson Home Historic Site to the National Park Service making it the 389th Unit of the National Park System?

As a result of being adopted by different families, brothers Robert DeForrest and Vincent DeForest's last names were spelled differently. As adults, they did not change the spelling of their last names.

What HBCU College President served on the first board of the Associated Publishers?

Don Speed Goodloe Mary McLeod Bethune Benjamin Mays Frederick Patterson

Dr. Benjamin Quarles surveyed the state of Maryland to establish the need for an organization that would be responsible for preserving African American History and Culture in the State. From this task, Dr. Quarles wrote authored a bill that Senator Verda Welcome approved and moved forward in the Maryland State Legislature to form what is now known as the Maryland Commission on African American History and Culture (MCAAHC).

All of these Goodloe and Quarles facts are published in the Journal of Negro History.
