

Louis E. Baxter, Sr., M.D, DFASAM, Founder, President & CEO, Professional Assistance Program of NJ, Inc (PAP). The PAP is the only approved organization by the State of New Jersey to manage doctors and other healthcare professionals dealing with impairing medical conditions. Dr. Baxter is also a Co-Founder and the Inaugural Program Director of the Addiction Medicine Fellowship Program at Howard University Hospital, the first among HBCUs.
