





Sunday VIP August Wilson Tour Experience with Dr. Kimberly C. Ellis, niece and scholar of August Wilson and His Works.

On Sunday, there will be a VIP August Wilson Experience Tour, led by Dr. Kimberly C. Ellis, who is Wilson's maternal niece and an American and Africana Studies Scholar. You will see the actual sites that impacted his life, served as the setting or references for some of his plays, as well as the film location of "Fences" and places of tremendous interest for Wilson fans and aficionados. During Denzel Washington's visit to Pittsburgh as he prepared to shoot "Fences," the Founding Executive Director, Attorney Paul Ellis, and his sister, Dr. Kimberly Ellis, gave Denzel Washington a private tour of the dilapidated structure and what it would mean to revitalize the home as the Hill District's economic anchor. You will hear details about this journey and understand how this relationship continues to unfold.

Peppered with familial and fun anecdotes, Dr. Ellis will share personal and professional stories about Wilson and his literary journey, ending the tour at the National Historic Register of Places the August Wilson House, where refreshments will be served and guests will have the opportunity to tour his boyhood home, which is a sight to behold!



Kim Ellis, Friday Luncheon and Sunday Tour

<u>Kimberly C. Ellis, Ph.D.</u> is a Scholar of American and Africana Studies, an Artist, Activist and Entrepreneur, as well as a playwright, world traveler and international thought leader on culture, gender and social technology.

Dr. Ellis is the Founding Executive Director of the <u>Historic Hill Institute</u>, the Historic Preservation organization of the neighborhood. As a scholar and public intellectual, in her capacity as Executive Director, Dr. Ellis is serving as the producer of the Freedom House Citywide Celebration on May 15, 2024 in the Historic Hill District of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, during the National Association of State Emergency Medical Service Officials (NASEMSO) Conference, whose participants want to honor the pioneers of the Freedom House Ambulance Services.

As the maternal niece of the late, great playwright, August Wilson, and having grown up on his plays in the famed, Historic Hill District that serves as the setting for the majority of of Wilson dramas, Dr. Ellis is an expert on his works, as both a scholar and practitioner. Dr. Ellis taught the first seminar course on August Wilson at the University of Pittsburgh, as well as the first seminar course on Wilson at Carnegie Mellon University. Dr. Ellis has also taught Black Theater and August Wilson's "Fences" in China, using a Mandarin script. She also teaches master classes and trains actors online. She is often the host and/or tour guide for the annual August Wilson Monologue Competition in Pittsburgh and, at times, helps train student competitors. She worked on the committee to create a National Historic Marker for the August Wilson House, which was unveiled during a community celebration in the Spring of 2007.

Dr. Ellis wrote the Introduction to the guidebook, "August Wilson: Pittsburgh Places in His Life and Plays" by Laurence A. Glasco and Christopher Rawson, published by the Pittsburgh History and Landmarks Foundation. Dr. Ellis served as a Consultant on the American Masters / WQED documentary on August Wilson and is also in the documentary, which aired February 20, 2015.

With her academic, familial and experiential knowledge and digital skill set, Dr. Kimberly Ellis served as the Digital Director for the August Wilson House, as well as for the National Black Theater Festival (NBTF). Over a decade ago, Dr. Ellis launched AW–L, the online discussion forum on the Life, Literature and Legacy of August Wilson, which boasts membership of national and international fans, scholars, educators, producers, directors, thespians, designers and other practitioners of August Wilson's works. A consultant and plenary session speaker for the first August Wilson Society Conference at Howard University, she continues to work to make his plays accessible by giving Teacher Training workshops online and in person, nationally and internationally.

Dr. Ellis continues to serve as a consultant and choreographer for various August Wilson productions, including "August in April," "Joe Turner's Come and Gone" and "Radio Golf" and has spoken on panels for the state-of-the-art, August Wilson Center for African American Culture in Downtown, Pittsburgh, PA. She is looking forward to the opportunity to finish her memoir about growing up on August Wilson's plays and what it was like to have such a close relationship with her uncle, while living in the Historic Hill District of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania and throughout her time traveling the country in graduate school. Dr. Ellis owns many of the digital assets related to all things August Wilson.
